Advent Devotional - Day 04

December 4th

Scripture: Luke 1:26-28 Verse: "In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee, to a virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David. The virgin's name was Mary. The angel went to her and said, 'Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you.'"



Reflection:

Mary's encounter with the angel Gabriel is a powerful testament to her faith and obedience. Despite the fear and uncertainty that must have filled her heart, Mary chose to trust in God's plan for her life.
