Advent Devotional - Day 14

Scripture: Luke 2:15-16 Verse: "When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, 'Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about.' So they hurried off and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in the manger."



Reflection:

The shepherds' response to the angelic announcement is a beautiful example of eagerness and faith. Despite their initial fear, they quickly decided to go to Bethlehem to see the newborn Savior.
